Trained as a high school English teacher, Rachel has taught at both the high school and college levels, though she spent the majority of her early adulthood as an at-home parent to three lively sons and as an active lay congregational leader. Once her children were in school, she served as a pastor of Christian formation, as worship resources coordinator for *Leader* magazine and as a spiritual director. At AMBS, Rachel teaches in the areas of Christian formation, family spirituality, worship and pedagogy.
