Nora Pederberg has been called to serve as Associate Pastor/Youth Leader at Nutana

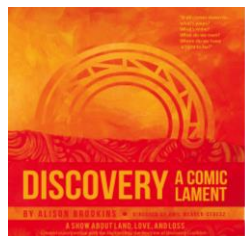
Park Mennonite Church for 11 months. **Sarah Unrau** began maternity leave after giving birth to Solomon Mackenzie, May 26, 2018.

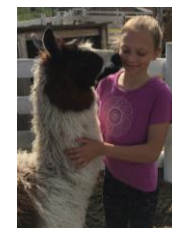
