Student Education Fund

Purpose

The purpose of the fund is to provide a tangible expression of the commitment of Mennonite Church Saskatchewan to encouraging attendance at schools, institutes and college affiliated with the Mennonite Church.

PART I

Eligibility

All members or regular attendees of MC Sask churches, and their children.

Assistance will be available for attendance at Rosthern Junior College (RJC), Canadian Mennonite University (CMU), Columbia Bible College (CBC), Conrad Grebel University College (CGUC), and Associated Mennonite Biblical Seminary (AMBS).

Benefits

Maximum amount available is \$500 per year per student.

Administration

A separate fund will be established for this purpose.

Student selection will be administered by the MC Sask Pastoral Leadership Commission. Council will be advised of the selected recipients.

Applications will be by prescribed form addressed to the MC Sask at the Saskatoon office. The benefits will be disbursed to the school or institution attended.

PART II

Fund Establishment

The fund will be established from sources as determined by Council, e.g. Bequests, and from designated donations.

Monies in fund will be invested with Mennonite Foundation of Canada.

Benefits Available

Only interest earned by the fund would be available for distribution.
