

# **Interim Youth Ministry Position**

### **Vision of Mennonite Church**

## **Statement of Identity and Purpose**

## **Ministry Mandate**

The Youth Minister/Worker works together with the congregational leadership to promote and support ministry for youth in MC Sask congregations and communities. This position will be a contract position to cover the school year 2024-25 (approximately 10 months) and travel to the MC Canada Gathering in July, 2025. The goal of this position is to maintain the momentum that has been built up with MegaMenno, the annual youth retreat and other aspects while MC Sask leadership reviews the youth ministry within MC Sask and establishes a plan to move forward.

**Time Commitment:** 0.25 FTE (average of 10 hours/week)

### Responsibilities

- 1. Coordinate and work with youth pastors, leaders, and sponsors on province-wide and regional youth events such as MegaMenno and youth retreats.
- 2. Lead and support SMYO leadership group.
- 3. Help plan and participate in youth event at MC Canada Gathering in Kitchener, Ontario in July 2025.
- 4. Support and resource youth ministry in congregations. This could include working with youth pastors, pastors, sponsors, and others in congregations as it relates to youth ministry within their congregations.
- 5. Other responsibilities may be added as needed and appropriate.
