Student Education Fund Scholarship Policy

Purpose

The purpose of the program is to provide a tangible expression of the commitment of Mennonite Church Saskatchewan (MC Sask) to encouraging attendance at educational institutions and service programs affiliated with the Mennonite Church.

Eligibility

Be active in MC Sask churches, schools, and/or programs.

Eligible Schools: Rosthern Junior College (RJC), Canadian Mennonite University (CMU), Columbia Bible College (CBC), Conrad Grebel University College (CGUC), and Associated Mennonite Biblical Seminary (AMBS).

Eligible Service Programs: International Visitor Exchange Program (IVEP, MCC), Seed (MCC), Service and Learning Together (SALT, MCC), Young Anabaptist Mennonite Exchange Network (YAMEN, MCC), 3E Internship (Youth Farm Bible Camp), and International Witness (MC Canada).

Additional schools or programs will be considered at the discretion of MC Sask.

Administration

Recipient selection will be overseen by MC Sask staff, Council will be advised of the selected recipients.

The benefits will be disbursed directly to the schools or program offices.

Funding

Maximum amount available is \$1,000 per year per recipient.

Funds will be established from sources as determined by Council (i.e., bequests, reserve funds), together with any general budget allocations deemed appropriate.

Recommended total annual program budget is \$4,000 with four scholarship recipients at \$1,000 each; to be amended as needed.
